

From the North -

From Hwy 11 south, exit at Hwy 69 south (to Whitby) proceed I Km through Washago and turn right at the road to Longford Mills (county Road 21) proceed south 8.5 KM. Turn right at Geneva Park entrance.

From Hwy 11 north, exit at Hwy 12 south (at Orillia) and follow 12 south until you are over the bridge at the narrows to Rama Rd, turn left and proceed past Casino Rama (don't stop!) through Longford Mills and turn left into entrance of Geneva Park.
